

BASEBALL TEAM UNIFORM PLACEMENT GUIDE

There are certain rules set by the regional baseball associations and leagues and the teams playing have to wear uniforms that abide by them. Before you begin designing, make sure you are familiar with the baseball team uniform logo placement guidelines of the level your team is playing at. Choose the colors, logo and number accordingly.

To help in designing, we provided you with the detailed baseball uniform guidelines below. Follow the instruction given below to design your baseball team uniforms to give them a professional look.



BASEBALL JERSEY

- 1. The preferred presentation of the manufacturers logo is 2.25" wide, positioned on the top right chest of the jersey.
- 2. The team name must be on the front side of the jersey in the center of the chest. The letters should be at 3" in size.
- 3. A patch (mostly the team's initial s or mascot) can be placed 3" above the end of the sleeve seam on raglan jersey right in the center.
- 4. The team logo should be on the sleeve, centered between the collar and sleeve seam,
- 5. The numbers should be placed at the left of the midriff. The size may not be smaller than 3" in width an d 6" in height on the front.
- 6. The league logo should be on the top center of the jersey back just below the neckline.
- 7. It is optional to have a players last name on the back of the jersey. The letters should always have a 2" gap from the top.
- 8. The numbers have to be placed at the center on the back. The size shall not exceed 4" in width and 8" at back side. Player numbers may have contrasting colored number.

BASEBALL PANTS

1. The player number display is optional on the top left side of the pants.
